BKL Walawalkar Hospital in Chiplun offers cancer treatment to rural areas. Whilst government schemes ensure recipients receive free treatment, there are limited sponsors for pre diagnostic investigations. Due to lack of funds for reports, most patients abandon treatment. RCQNM funds help patients cover the cost of pre diagnostic investigations and treatment assessments not covered by any schemes, ensuring no patient is denied care due to financial barriers.

Project Impact

In March 2022, RCQNM started to support adult cancer patients for diagnostic testing at the rural outreach center of Tata Memorial Hospital called BKL Walawalkar Hospital, Chiplun. We have committed funds up to Rs 25000 per patient.

Beneficiaries

1100 patients till date at an average cost of Rs 8000 per patient. All patients are from the low economic strata/ below poverty line in the Ratnagiri and Sindhudurg districts and across the Konkan region from Maharashtra to Goa across 2200 villages. We achieved 3X impact!

Type of Intervention

Whilst government schemes ensure recipients receive free treatment, there are limited sponsors for pre diagnostic investigations. Due to lack of funds for reports, most patients abandon treatment. RCQNM funds help patients complete their investigations and proceed for treatment.

Benefits to Community

Our funds cover patients not covered by any other scheme, and hence reduce abandonment rates thus increasing chances of survival for the patient.
