Project Summary:

Kshamta equips women survivors of gender-based violence to make livelihood & become self-reliant. They help women with employment-oriented skills to get employment. They also impart confidence and hope in these girls, enabling them to achieve their goals. Kshamta does this by working in the undermentioned three verticals:

- a) Super 30: Enrolment of 30 women in vocational training for job readiness, imparting life skills and enabling job placements and starting their micro businesses
- b) Vulnerable Community Intervention: They will be equipped with life skills, functional literacy, and get trained in vocational skills and be made work ready.
- c) Laptops, groceries and nutritional Support: To be provided in KTC group stay units

Project Impact and challenges:

- (a) Super 30: Phase 1 completed;
- 20 women have started working and earning, 6 have started their own small-scale business and are main bread winners in their families and 2 have completed their training and are awaiting their job placements.
- (b) Super 30: Phase 2
- 12 women have been signed up for phase 2, 7 of them have decided to run a small business unit, 1 has launched her readymade garment selling business and remaining 4 have been enrolled for their respective courses.

(c) Vulnerable Community Intervention (Outreach Project): Empowering and skilling of women from violence and exploitative backgrounds in government shelter homes.

Brothel Community: Setting up a new skills development center Laptops, Groceries and nutritional support to be provided to KTC center group stay units.
